Zygomatic Implants

Dr Costa, from ZAGA Centers Athens & Dubai, qualified as a dentist in 1984 receiving his dental degree cum laude from the University of Witwatersrand, Johannesburg, South Africa. He graduated at the top of the class and received numerous awards including the Gold Medal of the Dental Association of South Africa for the most outstanding graduate.

In 1990 he completed his 4-year full-time postgraduate Maxillofacial and Oral Surgery training at the University of Witwatersrand, South Africa and was awarded FFD (SA) MFOS. Since 1991 he is in a full-time specialist Maxillofacial and Oral Surgery private practice concentrating on the immediate loading of dental implants. To date, Dr Costa has placed over 50,000 dental implants. He has also presented as a key lecturer at numerous international implant congresses.

More treatment solutions with Nazalus Implants





DIRECTIONS TO THE SUNSKILL LAB

From the N1 (leaving Cape Town CBD)

- 1. Drive onto the N1.
- 2. Follow N1 to Mike Pienaar Blvd/M16.
- 3. Take left offramp exit 20 from N1.
- 4. Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Mike Pienaar Blvd/M16.
- 5. Continue on M16 to destination for 1.7 km.
- 6. At the traffic light turn right onto Francie Van Zijl Dr/M16 follow the road as it takes a bend.
- 7. Turn left at traffic light leading to Stellenbosch University Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences.


Once you enter the campus

- 1. Take the far-right lane and have your drivers license ready to sign in at security control point.
- 2. Continue straight, over the stop sign, turn left and park at 'P1 visitor parking'.
- On foot now cross the road and make your way to the last building you see on your right. It has large windows and is black. It is called the BMRI building.

Once you enter the building

- 1. Sign in at the reception desk
- 2. Turn left and walk to the 1st intersection.
- 3. Turn right and take the lift to the 5th floor.
- 4. Turn right once you step out the lift
- 5. You have reached Sunskill.
